

## UNIFORM DRESS CODE

A uniform dress code is designed to emphasize that which we have in common and to minimize our differences. Our uniform philosophy is that a student should be neat, well-groomed and in complete uniform from the time they enter the building until the time that they leave.

Therefore, students will dress in a manner that is neat, clean, safe, free from distractions, and brings individual and collective respect to each of us and to our school.

### Navy blue pants

- NO jeans are permitted or jean-like material.
- NO sweatpants, nylon or any pants that gather at the ankle are permitted.

### White Shirt, Navy Blue Shirt or Gray Shirt

- Short or long sleeves are permitted.
- MUST have a standard collar.
- MUST be tucked in at all times. **No Sagging**
- NO logos of any kind are permitted.
- NO band collars are permitted.
- A SOLID white, SOLID navy or SOLID gray t-shirt may be worn underneath.
- NO Hoods

### BOYS

Boys are to wear navy blue pants, a white, gray or navy shirt with a standard collar that is to be tucked in at all times. Students **must** wear a belt, and a full shoe with socks.

### GIRLS

Girls are to wear navy blue pants, long skirts, knee length skirts, or knee length jumpers, a white, gray, or navy shirt with a standard collar that is to be tucked in at all times, worn with a belt, sock, hose or tights and a full shoe. No form-fitted (tight) pants and skirts.

### Navy blue skirt/jumper

- Skirt/jumper length must be to the knee when standing in an upright position.
- NO skirt may be split higher than mid-calf.
- Skirts/jumpers can be straight or pleated.
- NO skorts or culottes are permitted.

### ITEMS NOT PERMISSIBLE FOR BOYS OR GIRLS

- Colored t-shirts or those with writing or designs on them worn underneath clothing
- Over-sized or sagging clothing
- Outerwear (jackets, vests, coats)
- Sandal type shoes
- Sleeveless tops or any top too short to STAY tucked in
- Any distracting hair color or hair style
- Warm-up suits, running suits, or jogging suits
- Wallet chains
- Earrings in the nose, eyebrow, tongue or lip
- Earrings or any material worn in the ear lobe (Boys Only)
- Wrist bands, hats, combs or sunglasses
- Clothing worn inside out
- Any current "fad" the staff deems inappropriate for school
- No Bib Overalls.
- No Hooded Items

### OPTIONAL WARDROBE

- Solid navy, solid white or Solid gray cardigan sweater.
- Solid navy, solid white or Solid gray sweatshirt.
- White or navy blue Monroe sweatshirt. These will be available for purchase at school in September.
- Short-sleeved white polo shirt with Monroe emblem. These will be available for purchase at school in September
- Long-sleeved white turtleneck.
- Sweaters and sweatshirts must have a white, gray or navy shirt with the standard collar or turtleneck worn underneath.

There will be consequences for students who repeatedly violate the dress code.
